Summary of the Message

The apostle Paul encourages us to endure, to continue on doing good in every single circumstance despite the difficulties and adversities around. We need to be intentional in doing the best and at the right time the blessings will come and will be poured out over us. Don't give up. Surrender everything to God.

Galatians 6:9 NIV

“Let us not **become weary** in **doing good**, for at the **proper time** we will **reap a harvest** if we do not **give up**”.

2 Corinthians 4:8-9 NIV

8 We are hard pressed on every side, but not crushed; perplexed, but not in despair; 9 persecuted, but not abandoned; struck down, but not destroyed.

- 1) **The Call To do Good:** Sowing the Seeds of God's Kingdom;
- 2) **The Reality of Weariness:** When it feels hard;
- 3) **The promise of the harvest:** Trusting God's perfect timing;

Start Talking: Spark Conversation

1. Have you ever given up on something you were doing for the sake of the adversities around?
2. Have you ever felt you couldn't continue on? What did you do to endure?

Start Thinking: Deepen the Thought

3. Why do you think people give up to achieve what God has already told them?
4. Which are the situations/problems/concerns that can make God's plan not happen?

Start Sharing

1. Share a personal experience when you were ready to give up but God said otherwise or when unfortunately you gave up and you were not able to relish from God's blessings

Start Doing: Commit to Act

1. What would you say to someone that asks for advice about enduring difficult times?
2. Which is the expected behaviour from a Christian when the problems are all around?

Heavenly Father, thank You for never giving up on us. Thank you for always being ready to carry us in your lap and helping us through difficult times. Despite your weakness and the desire to run away, your Spirit helps us to endure and do the best in every single moment.
